

Emergency Kits



In the event of a local disaster, the City of Edmonds has given each class a large storage tote to fill with necessary items that the staff and children may need for an emergency situation. These storage boxes will be kept in an emergency container beside the ball field off Dayton.

Edmonds Montessori requests that each student have their own emergency kit to be placed in these totes. These kits should be designed to help keep your child feel secure and comfortable under difficult circumstances.

In a *ONE GALLON ZIPLOCK BAG, LABELED WITH YOUR CHILDS NAME, PLEASE ADD THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:*

(The items don't need to match exactly, as long as it is equivalent to the list)

Emergency space blanket
Glow/light stick
Rain poncho
Warm pair of socks
Travel size disinfectant wipes
Travel size hand sanitizer
Child size mask
Granola bar
Beef jerky
Raisins/dried fruit
Can/Pouch of juice

We also suggest that you include a letter of comfort and a family photo.

Please return the kit to your teachers no later than the first day of school. There will be a (\$40.00) fee for any family that does not provide an emergency kit for their child. The unused kits will be returned to you on the last day of the school year.

Thank you for your cooperation and support as we care for your child in any uncertain circumstance.
